

THE KVTC BIOMASS CHALLENGE

To mark the company's 25-year anniversary KVTC will launch the KVTC Biomass Challenge in partnership with the Private Forestry Programme

Majority of households in Tanzania depend on firewood and charcoal for their energy needs and with a growing population this is resulting in ever increasing pressure on Tanzania's forests.

KVTC operates a forest plantation and sawmill in the Ulanga District (Morogoro) and supplies roundlogs to an additional four sawmills in the area. All sawmills are generating significant amounts of unutilized byproducts from their milling operations and none of the mills has been able to find commercially viable use for its sawmill residues.

KVTC believes that finding solutions to sawmill residues can offer some solution to Tanzania's energy needs and assist in reducing deforestation whilst at the same time offer economic opportunities for the company to monetize its waste products. More here: <u>http://kvtc-tz.com/news/</u>

The Challenge	KVTC and PFP invite entrepreneurs, individuals, private companies, SMEs, CBOs, NGOs and social enterprises with links to Tanzania or East Africa to submit a business plan that describes a commercial venture utilizing sawmill residues (sideboards, offcuts, shavings and sawdust) to be used to address the energy needs in Tanzania and that will positively contribute to fighting climate change and reduce deforestation.

Vetting and Judging Process	The panel responsible for vetting the business plans will consist of executives of KVTC and PFP supported by experts in the field of forestry, energy and business.
The Award	The winning business plan, to be determined through an open and robust vetting and judging process by a panel consisting of KVTC and PFP executives will receive a cash prize of TZS 75,000,000. The cash prize can only be used for capitalization of the projects/solutions and in addition KVTC offers a 6-month supply of free biomass from its sawmill. After the initial period of six months the biomass is to be procured on commercial terms (as described in the business plan). The winning solutions will have access to KVTC's network of investors and/or be exposed to financing opportunities, both within and outside the country, for scaling up their solutions.
